PHONE: For Phone Number Information: These numbers will be the primary contact when we need to reach you on the day of a rehearsal. For those under 18, please provide a parent's phone number and the cast member's phone number if they have one.

ITEMS YOU MAY NEED TO PROVIDE FOR THE SHOW: In this production, performers may be asked to provide basic costume items such as undergarments, socks, and shoes from their personal wardrobes and will be asked to purchase dance shoes for the production if they do not already own them and they are a part of the dance ensemble. If a cast member is unwilling to change their hair for the production and it is determined a wig is needed, the cast member is responsible for purchasing a wig approved by the Hair \& Makeup Designer.

If you have a theatre resume, you may attach it, but please also fill out the experience portion of the form.

CONFLICTS: Conflicts are something we have to live with, but it will help the production if you can be as complete as possible in listing your outside commitments. You may not be asked to rehearse at all the listed times, but getting a complete picture of conflicts will help us to cast the show and schedule for the best efficiency. Please list ALL conflicts you will have from June 10-August 11. Conflicts are considered in casting, and we may be unable to accommodate conflicts added after casting. If you have a conflict with a performance, we cannot cast you, but you might be able to be involved in other areas/ways, so please talk to us about it.

## STEP ONE

Please read the audition form instructions carefully. Fill out the form to the best of your ability. If you have questions, please ask our audition staff. On the top line of one side of each of the colored index cards, legibly write your name. On the second line, write your phone number. Return the form and index cards to our audition staff at Table 2 when you have completed them. They will carefully check your form and cards and may ask you additional questions or ask you to add more information. Once they have approved your form and cards, please enter the house/auditions area and wait for further instructions.

## CONTINUE READING AFTER YOU HAVE YOUR AUDITIONS FORM and CARDS APPROVED.

## STEP TWO

All auditioners will be asked to sing and dance. For your singing audition, please have your cutting ready. It should be no more than 32 bars $/ 1$ minute long. Please plan to sing with our accompanist.

When you are called to sing, please confer with the accompanist briefly. When the panel is ready, announce your name and song and perform. Please note that we may stop you if you exceed 1 minute in length. Occasionally, we ask you to do a few vocal exercises with the accompanist.

When called for the movement/dance audition, you will work with a group of people. The choreographers will teach you some movement and practice with you, and then the group will perform for the audition panel.

After this, some auditioners may be asked to leave and others to stay. Please don't assume anything from these requests.

## STEP THREE

Some auditioners may be asked to return for callbacks on June 1 . We will contact you if we wish to have you come to callbacks.

Casting takes a lot of time, and many variables impact casting. Please be patient with us as we build our show. We always contact everyone who auditions, whether or not we choose to cast you in this production. Whether or not you are cast, we hope that you join us this summer in some capacity. We have many backstage opportunities available. Also, we hope you join us again at our next auditions.

We wish you the best at the auditions. If you have any questions, please contact our auditions staff or stage management; they will gladly help you.
