

IT'S \$SCHOLARSHIP TIME!

Oregon Straw Hat Players has allocated \$2500 for scholarships for college studies and arts-related camps and workshops during the 2022 calendar year

- **\$400 scholarships** to OSHP members pursuing college studies.

- **Scholarships to camps and workshops** to OSHP members (18 years of age or younger) **for 50% of the cost of the activity**, exclusive of transportation to and from the site.

The minimum award is \$50 and the maximum is \$400, regardless of the 50% guideline. Camp/workshop activities must complete by December 31 following the application period.

*An individual may only apply for one type of scholarship.

*An individual may only receive college scholarship support for four years.

\$1600 is designated for college scholarships and \$900 for camps and workshops.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be submitted by plain text email (no attachments) to scholarships@oshponline.org by 11:59 pm on April 18, 2022

The application email must contain the following information:

FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS:

- List of all OSHP productions in which the applicant participated.
- Role(s) or duties the applicant fulfilled in the OSHP production(s).
- The applicant's current 4-point scale grade point average (high school GPA for camps, workshops, and seniors applying for college assistance, college GPA for continuing college students).
- a narrative of 300 words or fewer expressing what the applicant learned from OSHP participation.
- The field(s) of study the applicant intends to pursue and the college the applicant attends (or plans to attend).
- The applicant's current 4-point scale grade point average (high school GPA for seniors applying for college assistance)

FOR CAMPS AND WORKSHOPS

- List of all OSHP productions in which the applicant participated.
- Role(s) or duties the applicant fulfilled in the OSHP production(s).
- The applicant's current 4-point scale grade point average (high school GPA for camps, workshops, and seniors applying for college assistance, college GPA for continuing college students).
- The cost of the activity.
- A narrative of 300 words or fewer describing the activity's curriculum and expressing what the applicant hopes to gain from the activity.
- The applicant's current 4-point scale grade point average

The OSHP Board has the right to verify all application information. Incomplete or falsified information will disqualify the applicant.
